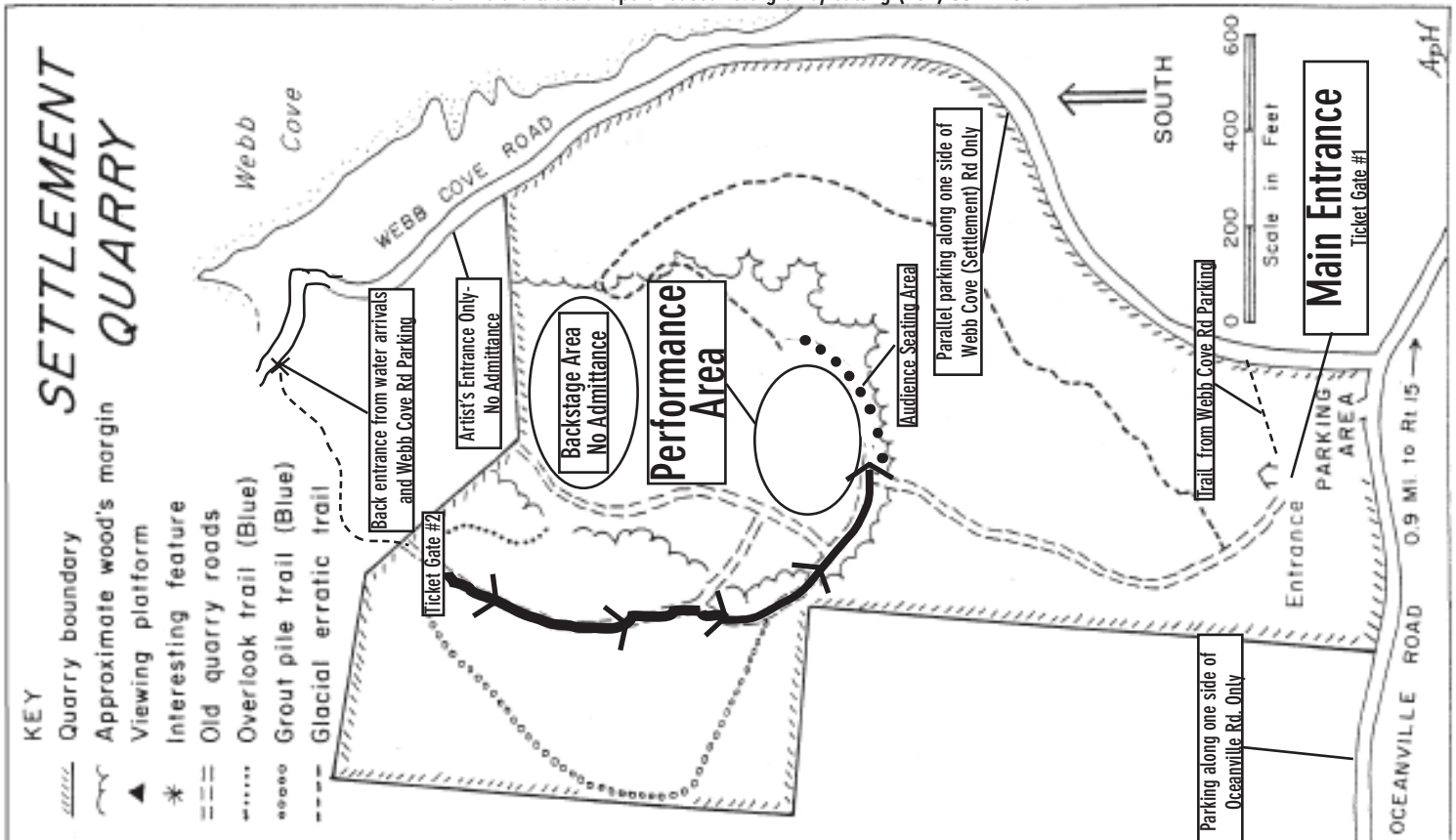


Q2: Habitat Performance Area Maps

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOUR ENJOYMENT OF “HABITAT” AT THE SETTLEMENT QUARRY

The Settlement Quarry is a lovely natural area, conserved by Island Heritage Trust. It is used primarily for hiking; it is not your traditional performance venue! Please wear appropriate shoes: the walk from the main entrance to the seating area is .25 mile, and you may have to walk further than that, from a third to a half mile, in addition from your parking spot. You may drop passengers off at the gate; we provide a shuttle for people with accessibility needs from the Main Gate to the seating area.

While there are many trails into and through the Quarry, we are using only TWO to enter: the Main Entrance, where the majority of you should enter; and a rear entrance for use by those who come by boat or park toward the end of Settlement Rd. Please follow the map on the reverse and CAR POOL and PARK accordingly.

PARKING IS EXTREMELY LIMITED.

Please park only in areas where an attendant shows you that parking is allowed.

SEATING IS ON THE ROCKS

Granite can be hard and uncomfortable if you are not used to it. Please bring camping or lawn chairs, or blankets, to make your viewing of the performance more comfortable.

YES THERE ARE MOSQUITOS (and port-a-potties)

Pretend you are camping rather than going to the theater: bring mosquito repellent, and water!

PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT

It is important we leave the quarry as we found it: pack everything out.
